



NORTHERN COLORADO CLEAN CITIES ANTI-IDLING CHALLENGE

In order to combat air pollution, reduce expenditures on energy use, and improve public health, Northern Colorado Clean Cities would like to challenge your organization to reduce idling. In support of this pledge, your organization agrees to at least three of the following anti-idling measures within the facility, the fleet, or amongst employees:

- Adopt state idling policy for all vehicles that limits excessive idling at your facility (i.e. more than 5 minutes/hour), including during pick-up and deliveries.
- Distribute an anti-idling pledge and informational sheet to all employees, which they will read and sign, in order to educate staff about idling.
- Install anti-idling signs near pick-up, drop-off or delivery areas.
- Ensure that your drivers will not idle unnecessarily (i.e. more than 5 minutes/hour) on or off site.
- Determine if installing anti-idling technology is possible for your fleet by pursuing funding through such sources as the Regional Air Quality Council.
- Spread the word about idling; host an idle reduction workshop or driver training session.

Together, we can keep Colorado clean and Coloradoans healthy now and in the future.

Remember, idling truly does get you nowhere!
